



Thomas Ryan Mock Obituary

December 13, 1918 - February 4, 2005

Ryan Mock, 86, of Albany, died at his home February 4, 2005. He was survived by his wife Anne Strickland Mock; a daughter Betty Mock Shine of Newnan; a son Ryan Mock Jr. of Atlanta; 2 grandchildren: granddaughter Holly Shine of Atlanta and grandson Daniel Shine, Jr. of Athens; 2 sisters: Margaret Charles of Tampa and Betty McGrady of Birmingham; a brother Genie Mock of Sylvester, and many beloved nieces, nephews and cousins. Mr. Mock served as an Infantry Unit Commander in the Army in WWII. He was in the Asiatic-Pacific Theater, where he received two Bronze Stars for the Guadalcanal and New Caledonia Campaigns, as well as the American Theater Medal, Victory Medal, and the Combat Infantryman Badge. He was decorated with the Distinguished Unit Badge. He was honorably discharged as a 2ND Lieutenant. After serving his country, he was employed as Vice President of Sales for Bobs Candies, Inc., for over 37 years. He was a member of St. Teresa's Catholic Church and the Golden K. Kiwanis Club.
