Thomas O. Owen, 91, of Smithville, died Monday, January 26, 2009 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital. The graveside service will be held at 11 AM Wednesday at Crown Hill Cemetery with Military Honors. The Rev. Bobby Harrell will officiate. A native of Tallapoosa County, Alabama, Mr. Owen had lived in Smithville for the past twelve years. He was a member of First Baptist Church of Leesburg where he served as a deacon. Mr. Owen retired from the U.S. Navy having served during WWII and the Korean Conflict, and then from Civil Service at the Naval Air Station in Jacksonville, Florida. He was preceded in death by his wife, Evelyn K. Owen, who died in 2002. Mr. Owen is survived by three daughters: Gerry Wagner and her husband Eric of Albany, Beverly Dockery of Smithville, and Debbie Owen, also of Smithville; four grandchildren: Mary Wagner Cansler, Kimberly Dockery Masters and her husband Matthew, Rick Owen Wagner and his wife Suzette, and Thomas Eric Dockery; nine great-grandchildren; a sister, Wylene McCarley of Phenix City, Alabama; and a brother, William P.
