Thomas Stokes Yarborough, 91, died Monday, October 10, 2011 at Magnolia Manor Nursing Home in Americus, GA. A native of Lexington, NC, Mr. Yarborough lived most of his life in Albany. He graduated from Davidson College where he was president of Kappa Sigma and played basketball, baseball and ran track.
