



Tom Daniel Obituary

September 29, 1934 - January 7, 2005

Tom Daniel, 70, who farmed in Terrell County for nearly 50 years, died early Friday morning at home in Albany. Born in Worth County, his parents were Howard Alton and Gladys Little Daniel. A partner with his brother, Jon, in Daniel Brothers Farm, Tom had a deep love and appreciation for the land. He was also an enthusiastic square dancer and round dancer, a pastime he enjoyed with his wife, Helen. Tom was passionate about his family genealogy and was an avid reader. He is remembered fondly by friends and family as a humorous storyteller. He often spoke of events that took place during his military experience, much of which he spent in northern Africa. Tom enlisted in the Army in 1955 and served until 1958. He was preceded in death by his parents and his brother Bill Daniel.
