



Tommy Goode Obituary

June 12, 1944 - November 20, 2011

Mr. Tommy Goode, 67, 1215 W. 3rd Ave, died Sunday, November 20, 2011 at his residence.

His funeral service will be Wednesday 2 PM at Life Christian Center International. Rev. Stan Glass, Mr. Ross Powell and Rev. Tim Bice will officiate. The family will receive friends Tuesday 6 to 8 PM at Kimbrell-Stern.

Raised in Bronwood, Mr. Goode had lived in Albany since 1969. He was retired from the Georgia Department of Labor as a Field Agent and graduated from Andrew College. Mr. Goode attended Georgia Southwestern and the University of Georgia where he played the saxophone in the Dixie Red Coat Band and played in several local bands, most recently with the Bo Henry Band.

Mr. Goode was an avid hunter and fisherman and would share the gospel with everyone he met.

Survivors include his wife, Nancy F. Goode, Albany; daughter, Jill Goode Schroeder and husband John, Albany; sons, Andy Goode and wife Patty, Springdale, AR, Tracy Goode and wife Teresa, Albany; sister Elaine Goode Love, Bronwood; grandchildren, Azlee Goode, Avery Goode, Adler Goode, Abby Goode, Anson Goode and Judah Schroeder.
