



Tommy Wayne Wilks Obituary

Tommy Wayne Wilks "Artic Wolf" of Terrell County, died Saturday, July 15, 2006. The graveside service will be held at 3 PM Wednesday, July 19, 2006 at Bronwood City Cemetery with Rev. Andy Goode officiating. A native of Thomaston, Mr. Wilks had lived in the Albany area for most of his life. He was employed as a customer service representative by Telecommunications Performance formerly known as CallTech Communications. Mr. Wilks worked for most of his life as a truck driver most recently with Sunflower Carriers. He teamed with his long time friend Raymond Hoover "Ghost Rider". Before becoming a truck driver, he was a supervisor for several convenience stores in Columbus and Albany. Mr. Wilks loved motorcycles and computers. He was also known as "Hero" to his family and friends and was of the Baptist faith. Mr. Wilks is preceded in death by his parents, Thomas Ralph Wilks and Jean Boyette; and a son, TR Wilks. Mr. Wilks is survived by his loving wife and friend, Frony Wilks, of Terrell County; a brother, Alan Boyette of Jesup; a sister, Judy Buckles of Connecticut; and his mother-in-law, Doris Grier of Cusseta. The family will receive friends at Kimbrell-Stern Tuesday from 6 PM until 8 PM.
