



Travis W. Thompson Obituary

August 30, 1935 - March 12, 2005

Travis Wayne Thompson, 69, of Albany, died Saturday, March 12, 2005 at his home. Mr. Thompson was born August 30, 1935 in Sale City, Mitchell County, GA. He was preceded in death by his parents, R. T. and Madel Thompson, and survived by his wife: Azalea Freeman Thompson; six children: Deborah and Dawn Fasick, Cleveland, OH, Keith Thompson, Albany, Steve and Tony Swilley-Francoeur, San Diego, CA, Donna Schilling, Dalton, GA, Melanie and Bryan Headrick, Dalton, GA, Shane and Janet Thompson, Albany; a sister: Eloise Hatcher; fourteen grandchildren; four great-grandchildren. Mr.

Thompson was a member of Gillionville Baptist Church and the Marshall Raughton Sunday School Class. Mr. Thompson was raised a Master Mason in Dougherty Lodge #591 on March 5, 1977. He was created a York Rite Mason on April 14, 1990. He was initiated into the Scottish Rite 32nd Degree KCCH November 4, 1995, 33rd. Degree Inspector General Honorary November 13, 1999; Venable Master Lodge of Perfection in 1996 and served on the Scottish Rite Childrens Hospital Committee 1998-2000. Mr. Thompson was installed as Sovereign of Albany Chapter of Red Cross of Constantine January 14, 2005; member of Royal Order of Jesters Albany Court 159 and Royal Order of Scotland; created a Shriner May 21, 1977, and was active in Masonry and Shriners in many capacities. He was Vice President of the Ritual Cast 1978-1979 and served as President in 1989. He also served as Aide 1981-1985; Major of Units 1982-1985; Colonel of Units 1986-1988; Chief Aide in 1989; honorary member of Legion of Honor and Ben Hillbillies. Mr. Thompson was

appointed Outer Guard in 1989 and served as Potentate (CEO/President) of Hasan Shrine Center in 1999. Other positions held in Shrinedom was member of Albany, Decatur County, Miller County, and Mitchell County Shrine Clubs; Trustee, Finance Committee and four years as Business Manager of Hasan Shrine Center.
