



Virginia Lee Bryan

January 12, 1936 - April 5, 2023

Virginia Lee Bryan passed away April 5, 2023 in her Tifton home surrounded by loved ones.

The graveside service will be held at 11 AM Tuesday at Crown Hill Cemetery with the Rev. Andrew Donaldson officiating. The family will receive friends Monday from 6 PM until 7:30 PM at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors.

Lee was born January 12, 1936 in Collingswood, New Jersey to Seaford Fox Jackson and Florine McDaniel Hill. Growing up, Lee spent time with her father during the summer but lived with her mother in Kings Mountain, North Carolina, which she considered to be her home. After her graduation from Kings Mountain High School Lee moved to Albany, Georgia to live with her father and to attend the Perry Business School. During this time Lee was introduced to Aaron Bryan, the love of her life. They married in 1955 and remained so until his death in 2005. Lee was a devoted wife and mother to three sons. The family attended Porterfield United Methodist Church where she was an active member of the Fellowship Sunday

School Class. Lee

retired from the Dougherty County School System after a long career serving as a secretary for a

variety of administrators. In her free time, she could be found on a variety of Albany ballfields

attending many sporting events in which her sons participated. She loved needlework and

sewing, the beach, the mountains, and enjoyed the company of her friends with whom she

attended concerts, took trips, and played bunco.

Lee was preceded in death by her husband Aaron, her parents, her younger sister Becky Hill, and

daughter-in-law Rebecca Crawford Bryan. She is survived by her three sons, Timothy Aaron

Bryan (Nancy), Mark Christopher Bryan, and Joel Randall Bryan. Lee is also survived by two
