Walter H. "Bud" Grimes, 70, of Albany died Sunday at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital following an illness. The funeral service will be 11 AM, Tuesday, March 22, 2005, in the Chapel of Sherwood Baptist Church. Dr. Michael Catt, Rev. Tom Pollock and Mr. Ross Powell will officiate. Interment will follow in Crown Hill Cemetery. A native of Miller County, Mr. Grimes has lived in Albany for a great many years. He was a 35 year member of Sherwood Baptist Church, the Ed Hughes / Bob Hembree Sunday school class, a past member of the deacon board and was a past Sunday school teacher. He loved to travel, was a Mason and he enjoyed keeping his yard to perfection. He was an avid fisherman, a member of Grand Isle where he loved to golf, played soft ball until he was past 50 and loved all sports, especially Georgia teams. He was a true Atlanta Falcon and Atlanta Brave Fan. He was a Marketing/ Rep. for more than 30 years for the Seibels, Bruce Company and worked for S. I. U. for over 3 years.
