Msgt Wayne Miller (USAF Ret.), 84, of Albany died Wednesday, February 13, 2019 at Willson Hospice House. Funeral services will be held Saturday, February 16, 2019 at 4:00 PM at Kimbrell-Stern. Interment will follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. Visitation will be held Friday, February 15, 2019 at Kimbrell-Stern from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM.

Born September 7th 1934 in Grady County Georgia, Wayne Miller faithfully served his family, state, and country throughout his life. Nicknamed "Spot" in a Bristol Florida high school, he was an all-conference football star and was known as the fastest player on the field. After completing high school Wayne enlisted in the United States Air Force, serving for over 20 years and retiring as a Master Sergeant. In his military career Wayne achieved the distinguished honor of receiving 1 Meritorious Service Medal, 10 Air Force Commendations Medals, 1 Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, and 20 Air Force Good Conduct Medals. Wayne served in the Strategic Air Command and was selected to attend and graduated from Officer Candidate School. After retiring from the Air Force, Wayne continued to serve other veterans in the state of Georgia through the States Department of Veterans Service for 23 years. He was a member of numerous veteran's organizations to include the Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW), American Legion, The Sergeant's Association, and the Disabled American Veterans (DAV). He is survived by his wife of 59 years Marjorie Miller, three children: Yvonne Jenkins, Yvette Miller, and Jack Miller.

He has 11 Grandchildren and 13 great grandchildren.
