March 13, 1931 - April 5, 2007

William L. Bush Sr., 76 of Albany died Thursday, at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital, following an illness. His funeral service will be 2 PM Sunday, April 8, 2006 at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors with the interment to follow at the Bush Family Cemetery in Baker County. Rev. Cathy Green and Rev. Chuck Auschwitz will officiate. A native of Baker County, Mr. Bush had lived in Albany since 1959 and was known by all as a "good man". He was a member of the United States Navy during the Korean Conflict. He was a long time member of Palmyra Road United Methodist Church, where he served as a deacon and usher. He was the past owner of W. L. Bush Insurance Agency, a member of the Optimist Club and he retired in 1997 as an insurance investigator for the Georgia Insurance Commissioners Office. Mr. Bush was preceded in death by his parents, Charles Peyton and Ruby Gleaton Bush, his wife Louise Cone Bush, and a daughter Shanon Bush Johnson. He is survived by his son; William L. Bush Jr. (Brenda) of Albany, 3 grandchildren: Trey Bush, Amanda Bush, and Zack Johnson; 2 brothers: Bob Bush of Baker County, and Charles Bush (Phyllis) of Sale City; 4 sisters: Hortense Bush Griffin (Charles) of Georgetown, Lucille Bush Smith (Wayne) of Adel, Gertrude Bush Copner (Johnny) of Roachdale, IN, and Patricia Bush Huey (Stan) of Camilla. The family will receive friends 5 PM to 7 PM Saturday at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors.
