



William N. Cox, Jr. Obituary

December 25, 1912 - August 31, 2003

Bill Cox was born Christmas Day, 1912 to William N. Cox, Sr. and Bennie Pearl Cox-Cox in Montgomery, AL. He moved to Albany while he was in the sixth grade. He attended Albany High School and continued his education at Auburn Poly Tech (now Auburn University) and Georgia Tech in Atlanta, receiving his degree in Architectural Engineering and Design. Among his many achievements in designs are Gracewood Rehabilitation Center in Augusta, GA and the design concept for the Lockheed-Marietta plant in Marietta, GA. He was also instrumental in the design of many of the hospitals, schools, prisons, churches, mills, and factories throughout Georgia. Bill joined the Lion's Club at the age of twenty-five. He served as club president, chaired many special events, and served on many committees at the state, national, and international level. Bill was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Albany, a lifelong member of: the Elks Club, the Walter H. Burt American Legion Post 30, and the AIA. Bill was a Navy veteran of WWII. He was preceded in death by his wife Virginia Cox.
