Mr. Frierson was born in Heflin, AL August 28, 1923 to the late Luther Sinclair Frierson and Mary Lou Moats Frierson. He was a graduate of Fitzgerald H.S., Fitzgerald, GA; Middle Georgia College, Cochran, GA; Georgia Institute of Technology, Atlanta, GA; and Southern Technical Institute, Marietta, GA. He served in the United States Army Air Corp. in San Antonio, TX and in the South Pacific during World War II where he received the Bronze Star.
