William Patrick Holton, 77, of Lee County, died Wednesday, March 13, 2024 at Willson Hospice House.

His funeral service will be at 11 AM at Friendship Baptist Church, 963 Ga Hwy 32, Leesburg, GA 31763, on Saturday, March 16, 2024. The Rev. Mark Spraggins will officiate. The burial service will be private.

Mr. Holton was born in Quitman, GA, and had lived most of his life in Albany and Lee County. He graduated from Albany High School, Albany Junior College, Georgia Southwestern, and received advanced degrees from Troy State and other universities. He was employed for many years and retired from the Dougherty County School System. Mr. Holton also taught at Darton College. He was a member and a Deacon of Friendship Baptist Church. He was preceded in death by his half-brother, James Clark Castleberry.
