



## Mr. William "Bill" Klewitz

Mr. William "Bill" Klewitz, 66, of Crestview, FL formerly of Albany, GA died Monday February 8, 2021 at St. Vincent Riverside Hospital in Jacksonville, FL.

A graveside funeral service will be held Saturday 2:00PM at Leesburg Cemetery. Rev. Steve Hurley will be officiating. The family will receive friends Saturday from 12:00PM at 1:30PM at Kimbrell-Stern.

Born in Washington, DC, Mr. Klewitz was the son of Ernest Klewitz and Mary Interdonato Klewitz. He graduated from the University of West Florida with a Master's degree Communications.
