A native of Daytona Beach, FL, Todd had lived in Albany since 1972. He attended schools in Albany, he attended Deerfield Windsor School and graduated from Albany High School, playing football at both schools. Todd attended the University of Georgia in 1980 and 1981, playing on the University of Georgia 1980 National Champion football team. He graduated from Florida State University in 1984. Todd was a member of Covenant Presbyterian Church. He was employed with Alltel Communications and was involved with the Phoebe Foundation. Todd was preceded in death by his father, Virgil W.
