William R. "Pat" Murphy, 79, of Lee County, died Wednesday, December 6, 2006 at his residence. The memorial service will be held at 1 PM Monday, December 11, 2006 at First United Methodist Church with Rev. Mike McAfee and Dr. Donald M. Kea officiating. A native of Bartow, GA, Mr. Murphy had lived in the Albany area since 1953. In 1949, he graduated from the University of Georgia and was always an avid Bulldog fan. Mr. Murphy served during World War II in the U.S. Navy. He was the Broker/Owner of Century 21 Realty, Pat Murphy Agency. Mr. Murphy then worked as a Bailiff for the Dougherty County Sheriff's office. He was a member of First United Methodist Church where he was also a member of the Fellowship Sunday School Class. Mr. Murphy was very involved in the Church Missions Committee and the Disaster Relief Ministry. He had been very active in the Jaycees for over 15 years and was a past president. Mr. Murphy is survived by his son, Ridge Murphy; Lou Murphy, his wife of 42 years; two sisters, Maybess "Sue" Cone and her husband Louis of Tucker, and Isabel "Bibble" Gurley and her husband Bill of Americus; and several nieces and nephews. The family will receive friends at First United Methodist Church following the service. 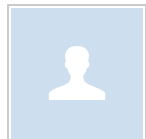
