William E. Vinson, 89 of Leesburg, died July 2, 2006 at his residence following an illness. His funeral service will be 11 AM Thursday July 6, 2006 at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors and the internment will follow at 3 PM at Evergreen Cemetery in Fitzgerald GA. Rev. A native of Americus, Mr. Vinson was a graduate of Fitzgerald High School, attended Middle Georgia College and was a 1939 graduate of Auburn University with a Bachelor of Science Aeronautical Degree. Following graduation became an Aeronautical Engineer and Airship Pilot. He enlisted in the United States Navy and served our country during WWII as a Navy Pilot and then served in the United States Navy Reserve and retired as Lieutenant Commander. He was a Shriner, a member of the Hasan Temple and a member of the Grand Chapter Royal Arch Masons of Georgia. He was associated with Vinson's Motors of Fitzgerald; past owner and operator of Vinson's Investors of Albany and Vinson's Realty of Eufaula AL. He was a member of Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church.
