William Earl Westmoreland, 82, of 1735 Marbury Lane, Albany, Georgia, died Friday, September 9, 2005, at his residence following a lengthy illness. Mr. Westmoreland was born September 6, 1923, in Whitfield County, Dalton, Georgia to Myrtle Short Westmoreland and Robert (Bob) Westmoreland. Born from his union of marriage in 1941 to Rhoda Young were three sons: Anthony, Mikell, and Raymond Westmoreland.
