Wilma Webb Hedrick, 93, a life long resident of Albany died Saturday, October 24, 2009 at Bill Nichols Veterans Home in Alexander City, AL. The funeral will be a graveside service at 2 PM Tuesday, October 27, 2009 at Crown Hill Cemetery. Dr. Don Adams will officiate. Mrs. Hedrick grew up in Jackson MS. During World War II she joined the Women's Army Corp and was stationed in Albany, GA. There, in 1945, she met and married Dermot Q. Hedrick of Albany, and they build their lives around their two children, the extended Hedrick and Webb families, and the First United Methodist Church of Albany. As "young" senior citizens, she and Dermot traveled extensively in America and overseas. Always active in the church, she was a longtime member of the Beulah Wake Sapp Sunday School class and the Women's Bible Study. She relocated to Columbiana, AL with her husband in 2002, becoming active in the First United Methodist Church there. She is survived by a son, Daniel C. Hedrick and his wife Beth of Columbiana, a daughter, Betty Sue Hedrick and her husband Gabriel Thy of Washington, DC: two grandchildren, Stacey H.
