



## Winsor Clyde Joines Obituary

February 9, 1921 - December 12, 2010

Mr. Joines was born in Anderson City in Worth County, and lived most of his early years in Macon, GA. He graduated from Lanier High School in Macon in 1940. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II in the China Burma India theatre from 1942 to 1946. He moved to Albany in 1946 and worked with M & M International Harvester Tractor Co. In 1950, he and James Pollock opened Dixie Tractor and Equipment Co. and operated the business until they sold it in 1978. Mr. Joines then worked with Albany Nut and Bolt from 1978 till 1997. He was a charter member of Sunnyside Baptist Church where he served as a deacon and was involved with many ministry activities. Mr. Joines was a member of the Walter H. Burt American Legion Post 30, the VFW, the booster clubs at Riverview Academy and Dougherty High School. He was married to a member of the Telephone Pioneers and was actively involved with the Telephone Pioneer Partners. Mr. Joines was very active with Junior Achievement at Southside Middle School, and gave books out to K-5 students throughout Southwest Georgia. He was preceded in death by his parents Vester F. Joines and Nellie Commander Joines; his brothers, Vester Lloyd Joines, Clifford Aubrey Joines, Robert Louis Joines; a brother-in-law, Browne Bass, Jr. He is survived by his wife: Ila Bass Joines, Albany; a daughter: Mary C.
